The Program

When you arrive in camp, you will check in at the lodge and meet your host. You will be guided to your cabin and meet your fellow den members.

Throughout the day, dens will experience archery instruction, BB gun shooting, crafts, games, the adventure course, skit training, nature activity and outdoor learning.

Between and after rotations, meals are served in the dining hall. The schedule features a campfire, chapel service and Polar Bear Hike to a scenic location.

What to Expect

Be sure to eat breakfast before arrival Saturday morning.

One son attends with each mother. *If you have two sons and you wish both to attend, a surrogate mom (e.g. an aunt, sister, etc.) who is 18 years or older should accompany the second son.*

All Boy Scouts of America policies regarding camp activities must be strictly observed.

Please pack your gear for a short walk to your cabin. No vehicles are allowed past the parking lot. This keeps our campers safe.

Alcohol is prohibited, smoking is permitted in the parking lot only.

Trading Post

A trading post will be open with camping supplies, souvenirs, healthy snacks, candy, pocketknives, and other items.

Insurance

Each participant must be covered by health and accident insurance. This is not provided by the camp.



Things to Know

Fee:

\$100 for a mother and son pair. Sign up by January 2010 to have a better chance at reserving a spot.

Refunds:

In the event of accident, illness, or **extreme** extenuating circumstances, refunds of **up to 50%** of camp fees may be made if requested in writing and received no later than 30 days after the date of camp. Refund requests (include unit number, name of camper, and the reason) must be submitted in writing to: Camping Department, Chief Seattle Council, PO Box 440408, Seattle, WA 98114.

Arrival and Departure:

Plan to arrive before 9 a.m. on Saturday. The camp program kicks off at 10 a.m. promptly. Camp ends at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday.

How to Register:

Reservations should be sent to: Chief Seattle Council, Camping Department., PO Box 440408, Seattle, WA 98114. (Please Note: Mom & Me is a pair event. Dens and packs are encouraged to sign up together, but a completed registration sheet is **required** for each pair. You may **not** hold spaces without names.)

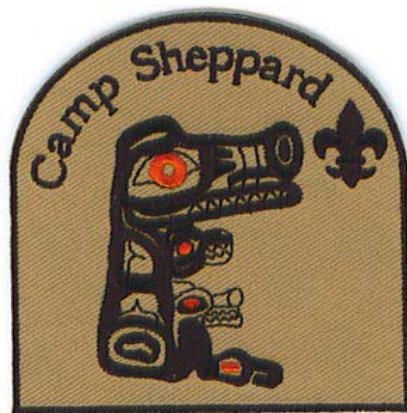

Directions:

From Seattle: Take I-405 to Renton. Take Hwy 169 exit (Maple Valley Hwy). Follow 169 through Maple Valley and Black Diamond to Enumclaw. Turn left in Enumclaw onto Hwy 164. This will lead into Hwy 410 at a light just beyond downtown Enumclaw. Go out Hwy 410 (approximately 35 minutes) to 1/2 mile past mile marker 52 and turn left at Forest Service Road #7155 into camp at the Camp Sheppard sign.
